# Specificity:

Antibody is produced by immunizing animals with A synthesized peptide derived from human CD26

## Storage buffer and conditions:

Antibody store in 10 mM PBS, 0.5mg/ml BSA, 50% glycerol (buffer) .

Shipped at 4°C. Store at-20°C or -80°C.

Products are valid for one natural year of receipt. Avoid repeated freeze / thaw cycles.

## Tissue specificity:

Expressed specifically in lymphatic vessels but not in blood vessels in the skin, small intestine, esophagus, ovary,

breast and prostate glands. Not detected in lymphatic vessels in the lung, kidney,

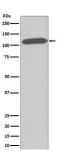

Cell surface glycoprotein receptor involved in the costimulatory signal essential for T-cell receptor (TCR)mediated T-cell activation (PubMed:10951221, PubMed:10900005, PubMed:11772392, PubMed:17287217). Acts as a positive regulator of T-cell coactivation, by binding at least ADA, CAV1, IGF2R, and PTPRC (PubMed:10951221, PubMed:10900005, PubMed:11772392, PubMed:14691230). Its binding to CAV1 and CARD11 induces T-cell proliferation and NF-kappa-B activation in a T-cell receptor/CD3-dependent manner (PubMed:17287217). Its interaction with ADA also regulates lymphocyte-epithelial cell adhesion (PubMed:11772392). In association with FAP is involved in the pericellular proteolysis of the extracellular matrix (ECM), the migration and invasion of endothelial cells into the ECM (PubMed:16651416, PubMed:10593948). May be involved in the promotion of lymphatic endothelial cells adhesion, migration and tube formation (PubMed:18708048). When overexpressed, enhanced cell proliferation, a process inhibited by GPC3 (PubMed:17549790). Acts also as a serine exopeptidase with a dipeptidyl peptidase activity that regulates various physiological processes by cleaving peptides in the circulation, including many chemokines, mitogenic growth factors, neuropeptides and peptide hormones such as brain natriuretic peptide 32 (PubMed:16254193, PubMed:10570924). Removes N-terminal dipeptides sequentially from polypeptides having unsubstituted Ntermini provided that the penultimate residue is proline (PubMed:10593948).., (Microbial infection) Acts as a receptor for human coronavirus MERS-CoV-2..
